
## GRILL SURROUND, PETERBILT 579

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Remove grab handle and all nuts from grill bezel except three as shown in Figure A.
- 2. Remove plastic from all bolt holes and from shaded areas shown in Figure A.



- 3. Carefully pry side edges of grill bezel away from hood and insert the 3 prongs of surround side in behind corresponding mounting areas of grill bezel.
- 4. Push grill bezel back into position securing surround sides and snapping into place. Peeled areas of surround sides should be tucked in behind grill bezel.
- 5. Attach brackets to surround top according to Figure A. Do not tighten fully. Allow brackets to slide freely.

- 6. Place surround top assembly on hood and align such that minimal gap exists between the surround top and area where the grill bezel meets with the hood.
- 7. Fasten the surround top to the surround sides ensuring top tucks behind sides and edges align. Do not fasten fully.
- 8. Slide brackets into desired position and mark through mounting holes on to hood.
- 9. Remove surround top assembly and drill through marked holes with Ø9/32" drill bit.
- 10. Mark holes on to front of truck through mounting holes on surround sides (see Fig A).
- 11. Drill through marked holes with Ø7/32" drill bit (see Fig A).
- 12. Clean area below grill bezel according to taping instructions provided.
- 13. Fasten the surround sides/bottom to the truck with 10-32 x 3/4" long screws provided. Do not tighten fully in order to allow space for surround bottom in next step.
- 14. Attach surround bottom by tucking behind grill bezel and surround sides. Align bottom edges of surround. Remove 2 sided tape and attach by peeling from center outwards.
- 15. Reattach the surround top to the sides ensuring proper fit as in steps 6 & 7.
- 16. Open the hood carefully ensuring grill bezel and surround stays secured.
- 17. Fully fasten the grill bezel and handle with fasteners removed in step 1.
- 18. Fasten the brackets to the truck hood according to figure B.
- 19. Fully tighten remaining fasteners and remove remaining plastic.
